Important guidelines on how to organize your trip to Anguilla during Covid-19 updated as of December 6th, 2021

- Visitors can only enter Anguilla if they are fully vaccinated. Accepted COVID-19 vaccinations are Moderna, AstraZeneca, Pfizer, or Johnson& Johnson and the final vaccine must be administered at least 21 days before your date of arrival.
- You must apply to come to Anguilla at https://ivisitanguilla.com/; we recommend starting the application process around 3 to 4 weeks prior to arrival. If you should have difficulties with your application, please let us know and we can assist you in this process.
- You must do an rt-PCR-Test 2 to 5 days prior to arrival (Antigen test must be within 48 hours
 prior to arrival). We strongly recommend doing an rt-PCR test 4-5 days prior to arrival to have
 enough time for the results.
- Update valid starting January 1st, 2022 if you travel via St. Maarten (for all travelers):
- a) If you are fully vaccinated with a booster shot at least 2 weeks prior to arrival or for children between 6 and 17 years old which are fully vaccinated (no booster required for this age group): no test is required to enter St. Maarten but you still must apply to enter St. Maarten online at https://stmaartenehas.com/application-form/; we recommend applying for your St. Maarten entry 3 days prior to arrival (there might be an error message if you start the process too early). Usually, you get your approval within a few hours, but for sure within 12 hours.
- b) If you are fully vaccinated but without a booster shot at least two weeks prior to arrival and 18 years and older, you need to have a valid PCR Test within 48 hours prior to departure or an Antigen Test within 24 hours of departure. As regulations might change quickly, please visit https://stmaartenehas.com/travel-requirements/ for the newest information. Usually, you get your approval within a few hours, but for sure within 12 hours.
- Since November 1st, Anguilla is accepting the following Covid-19 Tests (ALL TEST have to be done as nasopharyngeal swab (from the nose):
 - > Reverse Transcription Polymerase Chain Reaction tests (RT-PCR)
 - > Nucleic Acid Amplification tests (NAA)
 - > RNA or molecular test

ALL THE ABOVE TESTS MUST BE DONE BETWEEN 2 TO 5 DAYS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

> Antigen tests completed via a nasopharyngeal swab > only valid if done within 48 hours prior to arrival.

The laboratory that processes your pre-arrival test must be accredited. Self-administered home tests and antibody tests will NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- Once you receive your negative test result, upload it to your Anguilla application (needs to be uploaded by 12pm (noon) prior to the day of arrival). It can take up to 48 hours for approval, which will be granted if you tested negative and have done the correct test. If you do not receive your approval until 15 hours prior to departure, you can contact us, and we will try to assist from our side. If approved, you will also be charged US\$ 50.00 per person for the required arrival test in Anguilla.

Here the details of the Anguilla application:

1a. You apply and upload all your information to the website https://ivisitanguilla.com/. This includes your passport information, your vaccination information (upload PDF or JPG your vaccination card), your flight information as well as your health insurance details.
1b. You will receive a receipt by email that your application has been received, and your application will show a green 'property approval'. Nothing else will happen until you are ready to upload your Covid-19 test.



- 2. After you receive your test result, you can upload your negative test to the same website (again, pdf or Jpg format). You will receive your initial approval by email (and #2 in the above graph will show green as well). If you don't receive the initial approval within 24 hours after uploading it, please contact us and we can check your status with the portal team.
- 3. Now it can take a little while until you get the CMO (Chief Medical Officer) approval, making sure your test is done correctly. Also check occasionally if there is any message (see message box in the portal) as they would send you a message here if there should be any questions).
- 4. After getting the CMO approval (will show in green now as well), you should get an email asking you for payment of the US\$ 50.00 per person, which can be done online only in the portal. The payment is the last step of your approval. After the payment is made, it takes usually about 30 to 60 minutes to receive your final approval. You can print your Entry Certification directly from the portal. If you need any assistance or help in this process, please reach out to us and we are happy to help. If you have difficulties to do this yourself (if you don't have a computer or feel overwhelmed), please let us know and we can assist you in the entire approval process.

- c) If you travel via St. Maarten, we will assist you in booking your semi-private charter boat from the Airport in St. Maarten to Anguilla or you can also fly from St. Maarten to Anguilla. The public ferry from the French side is currently not running.
- d) On your arrival in Anguilla, your arrival PCR-Test will be done. After the test, you will clear immigration and customs and take a certified taxi to Carimar. You must stay on the property until you receive your negative test result (usually within 12-24 hours). You can take a swim, but you need to always keep a social distance (6 feet). We can arrange for some basic shopping for you prior to your arrival and we can order some dinner which will be delivered to your unit. After you received your negative test result, you are free to explore the island, rent a car and enjoy Anguilla as always.
- e) If you stay 8 nights or more, you MIGHT be asked to do another test on day four of your stay.

 > In the past weeks, none of our guest was required to do another test on day four. No need to stay in place or quarantine until you receive your negative test result (usually within 24 hours).
- f) When you leave the Island: Anguilla itself does not require a test when you depart. However, most countries, including the US, are requiring a test (sometimes an Antigen Test is sufficient) to enter their country. We can arrange the test for you a few days prior to departure. Cost of those tests are between US\$ 60.00 to US\$ 100.00 (Antigen test) and US\$ 100.00 to US\$ 150.00 (PCR-Test). Starting December 6th, the United States is requiring a Covid test one day prior to arrival in the US. Anguilla can provide the test in time and you will receive the result before your departure. We recommend strongly to reserve your test as early as possible in advance. Please contact us and we will assist you in arranging the test you need to travel back to your home. We can also arrange to have the test done at Carimar Beach Club, however, there will be a surcharge between \$15.00 and \$50.00 per person (pending on the day and who will do the test). Testing pricing subject to change.
- g) If you leave the Island via St Maarten: You will need to apply again like you have done when arriving (see details of protocols above). You can do the application again two days prior to arrival in St. Maarten and upload your vaccination paper. You receive your approval usually within a few hours, but not more than 12 hours. We recommend choosing air as form of transportation to St. Maarten (although you might take a boat) and then put your semi-private charter boat name as carrier.
