Anguilla discontinues all Covid-19 Entry protocols, effective October 1st, 2022

Unvaccinated Travelers Allowed Entry Without a Negative COVID-19 Test Result

Unvaccinated travels allowed entry without a negative Covid-19 test result; no pre-arrival testing or application is required.

On your arrival in Anguilla: There are no restrictions during your stay in Anguilla, regardless of if you vaccinated or not. Some businesses still require a mask when entering (including our front desk) and we ask you to maintain the same precautions you would take at home. Stay safe!

If you travel via St. Maarten

If you travel via St. Maarten, you still must apply to enter St. Maarten online. This is just a formality (no charge) but needs to be done 2-3 days prior to your arrival.

If you are fully vaccinated at least 2 weeks prior to arrival: no test is required to enter St. Maarten but you still must apply to enter St. Maarten online at https://stmaartenehas.com/application-form/; we recommend applying for your St. Maarten entry 2-3 days prior to arrival (there might be an error message if you start the process too early). Usually, you get your approval within a few hours, but for sure within 12 hours. Remember: You must apply again for your travel back home, if you travel via St. Maarten. There are no fees involved in this application.

If you are not fully vaccinated, below the requirements to enter St. Maarten:

We recommend printing your St. Maarten approval and take it with you, as you must present it to the airlines upon check-in you flight to St. Maarten.

If you travel via St. Maarten, we will assist you in booking your semi-private charter boat from the Airport in St. Maarten to Anguilla, you can take the public ferry from Marigot or you can also fly from St. Maarten to Anguilla. More information on our website www.carimar.com.

If you leave the Island via St Maarten (ferry to airport or flight): You will need to apply again like you have done when arriving (see details of protocols above). You can do the application again 2-3 days prior to arrival in St. Maarten and upload your vaccination paper. You receive your approval usually within a few hours, but not more than 12 hours. If you travel with the public ferry via Marigot, you don't need to fill out any application for St. Maarten.
